

PSALM 86 – NKJV 7.24.24.

A Prayer of David.

¹Bow down Your ear, O Lord, hear me; For I *am* poor and needy. ²Preserve my life, for I *am* holy; You are my God; Save Your servant who trusts in You! ³Be merciful to me, O Lord, For I cry to You all day long. ⁴Rejoice the soul of Your servant, For to You, O Lord, I lift up my soul. ⁵For You, Lord, *are* good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in mercy to all those who call upon You.

Hebrews 5:7;--'In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to him who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence' (ESV).

Lamentations 3:22;--'The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end;' (ESV).

⁶Give ear, O Lord, to my prayer; And attend to the voice of my supplications.⁷In the day of my trouble I will call upon You, For You will answer me.

1 John 5:14-15;--This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him' (NIV).

James 1:5;--'If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him' (NKJV).

1 Kings 3:7-10;--'Now, Lord my God, you have made your servant king in place of my father David. But I am only a little child and do not know how to carry out my duties. Your servant is here among the people you have chosen, a great people, too numerous to count or number. So give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of yours?' The Lord was pleased that Solomon had asked for this. So God said to him, 'Since you have asked for this and not for long life or wealth for yourself, nor have asked for the death of your enemies but for discernment in administering justice, I will do what you have asked. I will give you a wise and discerning heart, so that there will never have been anyone like you, nor will there ever be' (NIV).

⁸Among the gods *there is* none like You, O Lord; Nor *are there any works* like Your works. ⁹All nations whom You have made Shall come and worship before You, O Lord, And shall glorify Your name. ¹⁰For You *are* great, and do wondrous things; You alone *are* God.

Psalms 82:1;--'God presides in the great assembly; he renders judgment among the gods' (NIV).

Revelation 7:9-10;--'After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, 'Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!' (ESV).

¹¹ Teach me Your way, O Lord; I will walk in Your truth; Unite my heart to fear Your name. ¹² I will praise You, O Lord my God, with all my heart, And I will glorify Your name forevermore. ¹³ For great is Your mercy toward me, And You have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.

John 17:17;--'Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth' (NIV).

Psalms 1:1-3;--'Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers' (NIV).

Psalms 16:9-10;--'Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure. For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption' (ESV).

1 Peter 1:8-9;--'Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls' (NIV).

¹⁴ O God, the proud have risen against me, And a mob of violent *men* have sought my life, And have not set You before them. ¹⁵ But You, O Lord, *are* a God full of compassion, and gracious, Longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth.

Isaiah 2:17-18;--'The pride of man will be humbled and the loftiness of men will be abased; and the Lord alone will be exalted in that day, but the idols will completely vanish' (NASB).

Psalms 11:5;--'The Lord tests the righteous, but his soul hates the wicked and the one who loves violence' (ESV).

Exodus 20:3-4;--'You shall have no other gods before me. You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments' (NIV).

¹⁶ Oh, turn to me, and have mercy on me! Give Your strength to Your servant, And save the son of Your maidservant. ¹⁷ Show me a sign for good, That those who hate me may see *it* and be ashamed, Because You, Lord, have helped me and comforted me.

Psalms 116:16-17;--'O Lord, truly I am your servant; I am your servant, the son of your maidservant; you have loosed my bonds. I will offer to you the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and

2 Corinthians 1:5;--'For just as the sufferings of Christ are ours in abundance, so also our comfort is abundant through Christ' (NASB).
