

Psalm 92 - (NLT). 9.11.24

A psalm. A song to be sung on the Sabbath Day.

¹ It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to the Most High. ² It is good to proclaim your unfailing love in the morning, your faithfulness the evening,

³ accompanied by a ten-stringed instrument, a harp, and the melody of a lyre.

Colossians 3:16;--'Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, signing with grace in your hearts to the Lord' (NKJV).

Lamentations 3:22-24;--'Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is your faithfulness. 'The Lord is my portion,' says my soul, 'Therefore I hope in Him.' (NKJV).

Acts 16:25;--'About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them' (ESV).

⁴ You thrill me, Lord, with all you have done for me! I sing for joy because of what you have done. ⁵ O Lord, what great works you do! And how deep are your thoughts. ⁶ Only a simpleton would not know, and only a fool would not understand this: ⁷ Though the wicked sprout like weeds and evildoers flourish, they will be destroyed forever.

John 15:11;--'I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete' (NIV).

Isaiah 55:8-9;--'For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,' declares the Lord. 'As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts' (NIV).

1 Corinthians 2:14;--'The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit' (NIV).

Matthew 13:37-42;--'Jesus replied, 'The Son of Man is the farmer who plants the good seed. The field is the world, and the good seed represents the people of the Kingdom. The weeds are the people who belong to the evil one. The enemy who planted the weeds among the wheat is the devil. The harvest is the end of the world, and the harvesters are the angels. Just as the weeds are sorted out and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of the world. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will remove from his Kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil. And the angels will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth' (NLT).

⁸ But you, O Lord, will be exalted forever. ⁹ Your enemies, Lord, will surely perish; all evildoers will be scattered. ¹⁰ But you have made me as strong as a wild ox. You have

anointed me with the finest oil. ¹¹ My eyes have seen the downfall of my enemies; my ears have heard the defeat of my wicked opponents.

Revelation 5:11-13;--'Then I looked again, and I heard the voices of thousands and millions of angels around the throne and of the living beings and the elders. And they sang in a mighty chorus: 'Worthy is the Lamb who was slaughtered--to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing.' And then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea. They sang: 'Blessing and honor and glory and power belong to the one sitting on the throne and to the Lamb forever and ever.' (NLT).

1 Timothy 1:12;--'I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service' (NASB).

Psalms 119:28;--'...strengthen me according to your word!' (ESV).

Philippians 4:13;--'I can do all things because of Christ who strengthens me' (MEV).

¹² But the godly will flourish like palm trees and grow strong like the cedars of Lebanon.

¹³ For they are transplanted to the Lord's own house. They flourish in the courts of our God. ¹⁴ Even in old age they will still produce fruit; they will remain vital and green.

¹⁵ They will declare, "The Lord is just! He is my rock! There is no evil in him!"

Psalms 1:1-3;--'Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers. But they delight in the law of the Lord, meditating on it day and night. They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do' (NLT).

1 Peter 2:5-6;--'And you are living stones that God is building into his spiritual temple. What's more, you are his holy priests. Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God. As the Scriptures say, 'I am placing a cornerstone in Jerusalem, chosen for great honor, and anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced' (NLT).

John 4:21-24;--'Jesus replied, 'Believe me, dear woman, the time is coming when it will no longer matter whether you worship the Father on this mountain or in Jerusalem. You Samaritans know very little about the one you worship, while we Jews know all about him, for salvation comes through the Jews. But the time is coming--indeed it's here now--when true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth. The Father is looking for those who will worship him that way. For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth' (NLT).

Job 12:12;--'Wisdom is with the aged, and understanding in length of days' (ESV).

2 Corinthians 4:16;--'So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day' (ESV).

Psalms 71:17-18;--'O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim your wondrous deeds. So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come' (ESV).
