

## PSALM 96 - NKJV. 10.9.24

<sup>1</sup>Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! Sing to the Lord, all the earth. <sup>2</sup>Sing to the Lord, bless His name; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. <sup>3</sup>Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples.

Isaiah 61:1;--‘The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good tidings to the poor; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;’ (NKJV).

Romans 1:16;--‘For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek’ (NASB).

Romans 10:9-10;--‘Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved’ (NASB).

Revelation 14:6,7;--‘And I saw another angel flying in midheaven with an eternal gospel to preach to those who live on the earth, and to every nation, tribe, language, and people; and he said with a loud voice, ‘Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come; worship him who made the heaven and the earth, and sea and springs of waters’ (NASB).

Ephesians 1:7-10;--‘In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, that in the dispensation of the fulness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth--in Him’ (NKJV).

<sup>4</sup>For the Lord *is* great and greatly to be praised; He *is* to be feared above all gods. <sup>5</sup>For all the gods of the peoples *are* idols, But the Lord made the heavens. <sup>6</sup>Honor and majesty *are* before Him; Strength and beauty *are* in His sanctuary.

Nehemiah 9:6;--‘You alone are the Lord. You made the heavens, even the highest heavens, and all their starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to everything, and the multitudes of heaven worship you’ (NIV).

Isaiah 2:8;--‘Their land is filled with idols; they bow down to the work of their hands, to what their own fingers have made’ (ESV).

Deuteronomy 27:15;--‘Cursed is anyone who makes an idol--a thing detestable to the Lord, the work of skilled hands--and sets it up in secret’ (NIV).

1 Corinthians 10:14;--‘Therefore, my dear friends, flee from idolatry’ (NIV).

Colossians 1:16-17;--‘For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities--all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together’ (ESV).

Revelation 22:13;--‘I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End’ (NIV).

Philippians 3:8;--‘What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ’ (NIV).

<sup>7</sup> Give to the Lord, O families of the peoples, Give to the Lord glory and strength. <sup>8</sup> Give to the Lord the glory *due* His name; Bring an offering, and come into His courts. <sup>9</sup> Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth.

Psalm 63:3;--‘Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you’ (NIV).

John 15:8;--‘My father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit’ (NASB).

2 Thessalonians 3:1;--‘Brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as it did also with you’ (NASB).

John 4:23,24;--‘Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth’ (NIV).

Matthew 12:6-8;--‘I tell you that something greater than the temple is here. If you had known what these words mean, ‘I desire mercy, not sacrifice,’ you would not have condemned the innocent. For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath’ (NIV).

Colossians 2:16-19;--‘Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath. These are a shadow of the things to come, but the substance belongs to Christ. Let no one disqualify you, insisting on asceticism and worship of angels, going on in detail about vision, puffed up without reason by his sensuous mind, and not holding fast to the Head, from whom the whole body, nourished and knit together through its joints and ligaments, grows with a growth that is from God’ (ESV).

<sup>10</sup> Say among the nations, “The Lord reigns; The world also is firmly established, It shall not be moved; He shall judge the peoples righteously.” <sup>11</sup> Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; Let the sea roar, and all its fullness; <sup>12</sup> Let the field be joyful, and all that *is* in it. Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice <sup>13</sup> before the Lord. For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth. He shall judge the world with righteousness, And the peoples with His truth.

Matthew 25:31-35;--‘When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats. And he will set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. Then the king will say to those on his right hand, ‘Come, you blessed of my father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food; I was thirsty and you gave me drink; I was a stranger and you took me in; I was naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you visited me; I was in prison and you came to me’ (NKJV).

John 12:48;--‘The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day’ (ESV).

John 3:36;--‘Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God’s wrath remains on them’ (NIV).

Romans 1:17;--‘For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, ‘But the righteous man shall live by faith’’ (NASB1995).
